NOTES TO THE ABRIDGED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

for the financial year ended 31 March 2025

1. General Information

Lough Derg Marina Limited is a company limited by shares incorporated and registered in Ireland. The registered number of the company is 562273. The registered office of the company is Office Unit 1, First Floor, Newtown Centre, Annacotty, Limerick which is also the principal place of business of the company. The financial statements have been presented in Euro (€) which is also the functional currency of the company.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Companies Act 2014 and FRS 105 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable to the Micro-Entities Regime" issued by the Financial Reporting Council.

The company qualifies as a micro company as defined by section 280D of the Companies Act 2014 in respect of the financial year, and has applied the rules of the 'Micro Companies Regime' in accordance with section 280E of the Companies Act 2014 and FRS 105.

Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoice value of services supplied by the company, exclusive of trade discounts and value added tax.

Tangible assets and depreciation

Tangible assets are stated at cost or at valuation, less accumulated depreciation. The charge to depreciation is calculated to write off the original cost or valuation of tangible assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives as follows:

Freeholds	-	Not being depreciated
Plant and machinery	-	12.5% Straight line
Fixtures, fittings and equipment	-	12.5% Straight line
Motor vehicles	-	Fully depreciated

The carrying values of tangible fixed assets are reviewed annually for impairment in periods if events or changes in circumstances indicate the carrying value may not be recoverable.

Cash at bank and in hand

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash at bank and in hand, demand deposits with banks and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less and bank overdrafts. In the Balance Sheet bank overdrafts are shown within Creditors.

Trade and other creditors

Trade and other creditors are initially recognised at fair value and thereafter stated at amortised cost using the effective interest rate method, unless the effect of discounting would be immaterial, in which case they are stated at cost.

Taxation

Current tax represents the amount expected to be paid or recovered in respect of taxable profits for the financial year and is calculated using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantially enacted at the Balance Sheet date.

Government grants

Capital grants received and receivable are treated as deferred income and amortised to the Profit and Loss Account annually over the useful economic life of the asset to which it relates. Revenue grants are credited to the Profit and Loss Account when received.

Share capital of the company

Ordinary share capital

The ordinary share capital of the company is presented as equity.

4. Going concern

The company made a profit before tax of €22,333 for the year ended 31 March 2025 but had a deficiency of assets at that date of €455,718.

The directors anticipate that the company will continue to achieve profitability going forward. Furthermore, they have confirmed they are willing to provide financial support if required that will be sufficient for the company to pay its debts as they fall due.

As a result, the directors believe it is appropriate to presume that the company will continue in business and the financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. The financial statements do not include any adjustments that would result if these expectations are not met.

5. Post-Balance Sheet Events

There have been no significant events affecting the company since the financial year-end.

6. Approval of financial statements

The financial statements were approved and authorised for issue by the board of directors on 17 December 2025.
