- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in business.





## **pursuant to section 356(1) and 356(2) of the Companies Act 2014**

### **Opinion**

In our opinion the directors are entitled under section 352 of the Companies Act 2014 to annex the abridged financial statements to the annual return of Footsteps Care - a Company limited by Guarantee not having a share capital ('the company') and those abridged financial statements have been properly prepared pursuant to the provisions of section 353 of that Act (exemptions available to small companies).

### **Basis of opinion**

We have examined :

- (i) the abridged financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2025 on pages 8 to 12 which the directors of Footsteps Care - a Company limited by Guarantee not having a share capital propose to annex to the annual return of the company; and



# Footsteps Care - a Company limited by Guarantee not having a share capital

## NOTES TO THE ABRIDGED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

for the financial year ended 31 December 2025

### 1. General Information

Footsteps Care - a Company limited by Guarantee not having a share capital is a company limited by guarantee incorporated and registered in Ireland. The registered number of the company is 638961. The registered office of the company is Unit C1, Nutgrove Office Park, Nutgrove Avenue, Rathfarham, Dublin 14. Footsteps Care is a company limited by guarantee providing one-off grants for patients in need of convalescent care following surgical medical treatment in hospital. The financial statements have been presented in Euro (€) which is also the functional currency of the company. On 1 January 2020 the company took over the assets, liabilities and activities of Footsteps (the operating name of Convalescent Home Stillorgan incorporated by Royal Charter). The value of the net assets taken over amounted to €1,079,822 and have been shown as capital reserves and funds on the balance sheet.

### 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

#### Statement of compliance

The financial statements of the company for the financial year ended 31 December 2025 have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of FRS 102 Section 1A (Small Entities) and the Companies Act 2014.

#### Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention except for certain properties and financial instruments that are measured at revalued amounts or fair values, as explained in the accounting policies below. Historical cost is generally based on the fair value of the consideration given in exchange for assets. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Companies Act 2014 and FRS 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" Section 1A, issued by the Financial Reporting Council.

The company qualifies as a small company as defined by section 280A of the Companies Act 2014 in respect of the financial year, and has applied the rules of the 'Small Companies Regime' in accordance with section 280C of the Companies Act 2014 and Section 1A of FRS 102.

#### Income

Dividends, realised gains and other income are recorded in the period in which they occur.

#### Financial assets

Quoted investments are stated at share value inclusive of unrealised gains or losses.

#### Taxation

Exemption from direct taxation has been granted to the company by the Revenue Commissioners on account of the charitable nature of its activities.

### 3. Provisions Available for Audits of Small Entities

In common with many other businesses of our size and nature, we use our auditors to prepare and submit tax returns to the Revenue and to assist with the preparation of the financial statements.
