- state whether the financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards, identify those standards, and note the effect and the reasons for any material departure from those standards; and
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Company will continue in business.



Notes to the Abridged Financial Statements For the Financial Year Ended 31 May 2025

1. General information

These financial statements comprising the Profit and Loss Account, the Balance Sheet, and related notes constitute the individual financial statements of Nail by Annabel Ireland Limited for the financial year ended 31 May 2025.

Nails by Annabel Ireland Limited is a private company limited by shares, incorporated in the Republic of Ireland. The registered office's address is 20 Harcourt Street, Dublin 2 which is also the principal place of business of the Company (registered number 683856). The nature of the Company's operation and its principal activities are set out in the Directors' Report.

Statement of compliance

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with FRS 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' (FRS 102), as adapted by Section 1A.

Currency

The financial statements have been presented in Euro (€) which is also the functional currency of the company.

Accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

2. Accounting policies

2.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, under the historical cost convention unless otherwise specified within these accounting policies and in accordance with Section 1A of Financial Reporting Standard 102, the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland and the Companies Act 2014.

The company has taken advantage of the disclosure option of preparing a single statement of profit and loss and retained earnings as permitted by the FRS102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland.

2.2 Compliance fees

Statutory compliance fees are borne by the controlling party.

2. Accounting policies (continued)

2.3 Taxation

Tax is recognised in profit or loss except that a charge attributable to an item of income and expense recognised as other comprehensive income or to an item recognised directly in equity is also recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity respectively.

The current income tax charge is calculated on the basis of tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date in the countries where the Company operates and generates income.

Deferred tax balances are recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date, except that:

- The recognition of deferred tax assets is limited to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits; and
- Any deferred tax balances are reversed if and when all conditions for retaining associated tax allowances have been met.

Deferred tax balances are not recognised in respect of permanent differences except in respect of business combinations, when deferred tax is recognised on the differences between the fair values of assets acquired and the future tax deductions available for them and the differences between the fair values of liabilities acquired and the amount that will be assessed for tax. Deferred tax is determined using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

2.4 Debtors

Short-term debtors are measured at transaction price, less any impairment. Loans receivable are measured initially at fair value, net of transaction costs, and are measured subsequently at amortised cost using the effective interest method, less any impairment.

2.5 Ordinary share capital

The ordinary share capital of the company is presented as equity.

3. Judgments in applying accounting policies

The directors consider the accounting assumptions below to be its critical accounting judgments:

Going concern

The accounts are prepared on a going concern basis. This going concern basis is subject to controlling party support to cover compliance costs, which the directors have received confirmation of. The directors are confident that the business will continue and the financial statements have, accordingly, been prepared on a going concern basis. The financial statements do not include adjustments that would result if the company was unable to continue as a going concern.

4. Employees

The Company has no employees other than the directors, who did not receive any remuneration (2024 - €NIL).
