## Report on the audit of the financial statements

### **Opinion**

##### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The financial statements comprising the Profit and Loss Account, Balance Sheet and the related notes constitute the individual financial statements of DMASC Limited for the financial year ended 28 February 2025.

DMASC Limited is a private company limited by shares (registered under Part 2 of Companies Act 2014), incorporated and registered in the Republic of Ireland, CRO number 578319. The registered office is Rahanane, Kilcummin, Killarney, Co. Kerry, Co. Dublin, which is also the principal place of business. The nature of the company's operations and its principal activities are set out in the Directors Report.

##### STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

The financial statements have been prepared in compliance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard Applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and Companies Act 2014.

##### CURRENCY

The financial statements have been presented in the Euro currency (€) which is also the functional currency of the company.

##### 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The significant accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented unless otherwise stated.

###### a) *Basis of financial statements*

The financial statements have been prepared in compliance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard Applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and Companies Act 2014. The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis under the historical cost convention, modified to include certain items at fair value.

###### b) *Turnover*

Turnover represents net sales to customers and excludes VAT. Turnover is recognised upon delivery to customer.
